Course Fee is £45. **(Cheques payable to 'Cherwell Canoe Club')** This includes use of equipment and facilities at the reservoir. In addition to this club membership until the next renewal (March 2011) is included. There are a maximum of 12 people on each course, with a first-come-first-served allocation of places on receipt of payment. All courses are held at Banbury Cross Sailing Club at Grimsbury Reservoir in Banbury. On completion of the 5 wk course a river trip lasting approximately 2-3 hours will be offered. This will normally be on a Sunday at Stratford-upon-Avon although the date and location are subject to change dependent on water levels. Attendees are responsible for arranging their own transport to and from the river trip. Please wear clothing suitable for getting wet in and bring a change of clothes. If you have one, a lightweight windproof cagoule is useful for cool / breezy conditions. Suitable footwear must be worn at all times when on the water. Applicants must be able to swim a minimum of 25 metres in normal canoeing attire. **The minimum age for attendance is 9 years. Under 18's must have a parent or guardians consent.**
